PROCLAMATION APPOINTING A DATE FOR A GENERAL ELECTION OF ELECTED MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF MONTSERRAT.

**A PROCLAMATION
BY THE GOVERNOR**

WHEREAS by section 43 of Schedule II to the Montserrat Constitution Order 1989 (S.I. 1989 No. 2401) it is provided that a general election of elected members of the Legislative Council shall be held at such time within three months after the dissolution of the Council as the Governor shall appoint by Proclamation published in the Gazette;

AND WHEREAS the said Council was dissolved on the 16th day of June, 2009.

NOW THEREFORE, I, PETER ANDREW WATERWORTH, Governor, by virtue of the powers vested in me by the said provisions of the said Order, do by this my Proclamation, hereby appoint the 8th day of September, 2009 as the day on which general election of elected members of the said Council shall be held.

AND all Her Majesty's loving subjects in Montserrat, and all those whom it may concern are hereby required to take due notice hereof.
