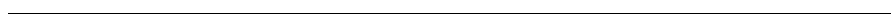

**THE IMMIGRATION (ECONOMIC RESIDENCE PERMIT) (FEES)
REGULATIONS, 2013 MADE BY THE GOVERNOR ACTING ON
THE ADVICE OF CABINET UNDER SECTION 39 OF THE
IMMIGRATION ACT (CAP. 13.01).**

1. Short title and commencement

These Regulations may be cited as the Immigration (Economic Residence Permit) (Fees) Regulations 2013 and come into force on the 5th April, 2013.

2. Interpretation

In these Regulations—

“**Caricom National**” means a person who—

- (i) is a citizen of a member state of the Caribbean Community (Caricom); or
- (ii) has a connection with a member state of the Caribbean Community (Caricom) of a kind which entitles that person to be regarded as belonging to it, or, if it be so expressed as being a native or national of that member state for the purpose of its laws relating to Immigration.

3. Fees

The fees payable for the issue of economic residence permit shall be in accordance with the scale of fees set out in the Schedule.
