

CHAPTER 102.**ALIENS RESTRICTION.**

4/1929

(3rd July, 1929.)

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Aliens Restriction Ordinance. Short title.

2. No alien shall act as master, chief officer, or chief engineer of a merchant ship registered in the Colony or as skipper or second hand of a fishing boat registered in the Colony, except in the case of a ship or boat employed habitually in voyages between ports outside the Colony : Aliens not to act as masters of ships registered in the Colony.

Provided that this prohibition shall not apply to any alien who has acted as a master, chief officer or chief engineer of a British ship, or as a skipper or second hand of a British fishing boat, at any time during the war and is certified by the Admiralty to have performed good and faithful service in that capacity.

3. Any person who acts in contravention of this Ordinance or who aids or abets any person in any contravention of this Ordinance shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding ninety-six dollars or to imprisonment, with or without hard labour, for a term not exceeding six months, or to both such fine and imprisonment. Penalty.
