AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE COMPUTATION OF GRATUITY AND PENSION
IN RESPECT OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE OF JOSEPH WILLIAM BASS.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council of Montserrat, and
by the authority of the same as follows:—

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Joseph William Bass (Pension) Ordinance, 1985. Short Title.

2 Notwithstanding the provisions of any law to the contrary, it is hereby declared that for the purposes of the Pensions Act and the Pensions Regulations the qualifying service and the pensionable service of Joseph William Bass shall be deemed to have commenced on his appointment to the public service on 5th January, 1959, and to have continued without break in service up to the date of enactment of this Ordinance, and any gratuity or pension that may become due to him on his retirement from the public service shall be computed accordingly; provided always that in such computation of the amount of any gratuity or pension there shall be deducted an amount calculated *pro rata* in respect of the periods 9th September 1962 to 13th September 1965 inclusive, and 4th November 1967 to 28th February 1971 inclusive. Authority to compute gratuity and pension of service from the 14th September, 1965.
