

## CHAPTER 219.

### LEGAL OFFICERS (APPOINTMENT, DISMISSAL AND DISCIPLINARY CONTROL).

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Legal Officers (appointment, dismissal and disciplinary control) Ordinance. Short title.

2. In this Ordinance—

“the Judicial and Legal Service Commission” means the Judicial and Legal Service Commission established by the Windward Islands and Leeward Islands (Courts) Order in Council, 1959; Interpretation.

“the public service” means the service of the Crown in a civil capacity in respect of the Government of the Colony.

3. (1) Subject to the provisions of this section, power to make appointments to the offices to which this Ordinance applies and to dismiss and to exercise disciplinary control over persons holding or acting in such offices shall vest in the Administrator acting after consultation with the Judicial and Legal Service Commission. Appointments, etc., of certain legal officers.

(2) Power to appoint a person to act in any office to which this Ordinance applies during any period during which it is vacant or the holder thereof is unable for any reason to perform the functions of that office shall vest in the Administrator acting after consultation with the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court.

(3) This Ordinance applies to the offices of Crown Attorney and Legal Assistant and to such other offices in the public service, for appointment to which persons are required to possess legal qualification, as may be prescribed by any law enacted by the Legislature of the Colony.
