AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE COMPUTATION OF GRATUITY AND PENSION IN RESPECT OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE OF MARY ANN ELIZABETH FENTON

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council of Montserrat, and by the authority of the same as follows:-

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Mary Ann Elizabeth Fenton (Pension) Ordinance, 1985. Short Title.

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law to the contrary, it is hereby declared that for the purposes of the Pensions Act and the Pensions Regulations the qualifying service and the pensionable service of Mary Ann Elizabeth Fenton shall be deemed to have commenced on her appointment to the public service on 14th January, 1957 and to have continued without break in service up to the date of enactment of this Ordinance, and any gratuity or pension that may become due to her on her retirement from the public service shall be computed according; provided always that in such computation of the amount of any gratuity or pension there shall be deducted an amount calculated *pro rata* in respect of the periods 30th September 1960 to 8th September 1963 inclusive, and 13th February 1968 to 8th September 1968 inclusive.

Authority to compute gratuity and pension in respect of service from 14th January, 1957.
