RUM (REFUND OF DUTY).

4/1922

(8th June, 1922.)

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Rum (refund of duty) Ordinance. Short title.

2. Where any bay rum is exported from the Colony and at the time of exportation thereof is shown by the exporter to the satisfaction of the Treasurer to have been therein manufactured from rum in respect of which the import duty imposed by any Ordinance for the time being in force has been paid, the exporter shall, subject to such regulations as the Administrator in Council may prescribe for ascertaining the quantity and strength of rum contained in such bay rum, be entitled to obtain from the Treasurer a refund of the amount of import duty paid on the quantity of rum so contained.
