

CHAPTER 285.**SAFETY MATCH.**

(27th April, 1927.)

- 1.** This Ordinance may be cited as the Safety Match Ordinance. Short title.
- 2.** In this Ordinance the expression "safety match" means a match only igniting on a specially prepared surface. Interpretation
- 3.** Any person who on or after the first day of July, 1927, shall :— Offences.
- (a) manufacture, or
 - (b) sell, or expose or offer for sale, or have in his possession for the purpose of sale, or
 - (c) import,
- any matches other than safety matches, shall be guilty of an offence under this Ordinance and shall upon summary conviction be liable to a fine not exceeding two hundred and forty dollars.
- 4.** Any matches, other than safety matches, found on or after the first day of July, 1927, in the possession of any person whether he shall have been convicted of an offence under this Ordinance or not, may be seized by a police officer and, by the order of a Magistrate, destroyed. Seizure and destruction of matches other than safety matches.
