

**CHAPTER 211.**

**SALE OF MEAT (PLYMOUTH).**

14/1907

[15th November, 1907.]

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Sale of Meat (Plymouth) Ordinance. Short title.  
(new).
2. In this Ordinance the expression "meat" shall mean any part of the flesh of the following animals:—Cattle, sheep, goats, pigs. Interpretation.
3. No meat shall be bought, sold, or exposed for sale within the town of Plymouth as defined by Section 20 of the Public Health Ordinance, save only in the Plymouth Market, and unless such meat shall have been slaughtered in the public slaughter house in the said market. Sale of meat.

4. Any person contravening any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be liable on summary conviction to a penalty not exceeding twenty-four dollars. Penalty.
