CHAPTER 320.

TEXTILES QUOTA ORDINANCE.

THE TEXTILES QUOTA REGULATIONS, MADE UNDER SECTION 9 OF THE TEXTILES QUOTA ORDINANCE.

1. SHORT TITLE. These Regulations may be cited as the Textiles Quota Regulations.

2. CERTIFICATE OF ORIGIN. The Treasurer shall require the production of a certificate of origin for all textiles of kinds subject to quota imported from the United Kingdom or Hong Kong, in the form set out in Schedule A where the value of the consignment exceeds twenty-four dollars, and in the form set out in Schedule B where the value of the consignment does not exceed twenty-four dollars.

3. ENDORSEMENT ON CERTIFICATE. The certificate of origin shall bear on it either—

(a) the endorsement in the form set out in Schedule C of a Chamber of Commerce named in Schedule D; or

(b) the endorsement in the form set out in Schedule E of the Federation of British Industries; or

(c) the endorsement set out in Schedule F of the Superintendent of Imports and Exports of Hong Kong:

Provided that where the consignment is of a value not exceeding twentyfour dollars no endorsement shall be necessary if the said Certificate be duly stamped with the stamp or seal of the certifying authority.

4. POWERS OF TREASURER. (1) In exceptional circumstances when an importer is unable to produce the certificate of origin required by these regulations, the Treasurer may admit textiles of kinds above-mentioned into the Colony on his being satisfied that the same are of Commonwealth origin.

CHAPTER 320.

TEXTILES QUOTA ORDINANCE.

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1. SHORT TITLE. These Regulations may be cited as the Textiles Quota Regulations.

2. CERTIFICATE OF ORIGIN. The Treasurer shall require the production of a certificate of origin for all textiles of kinds subject to quota imported from the United Kingdom or Hong Kong, in the form set out in Schedule A where the value of the consignment exceeds twenty-four dollars, and in the form set out in Schedule B where the value of the consignment does not exceed twenty-four dollars.

3. ENDORSEMENT ON CERTIFICATE. The certificate of origin shall bear on it either—

(a) the endorsement in the form set out in Schedule C of a Chamber of Commerce named in Schedule D; or

(b) the endorsement in the form set out in Schedule E of the Federation of British Industries; or

(c) the endorsement set out in Schedule F of the Superintendent of Imports and Exports of Hong Kong:

Provided that where the consignment is of a value not exceeding twentyfour dollars no endorsement shall be necessary if the said Certificate be duly stamped with the stamp or seal of the certifying authority.

4. POWERS OF TREASURER. (1) In exceptional circumstances when an importer is unable to produce the certificate of origin required by these regulations, the Treasurer may admit textiles of kinds above-mentioned into the Colony on his being satisfied that the same are of Commonwealth origin.

(2) The Treasurer may, by notice in the *Gazette*, add to the list of Chambers of Commerce specified in Schedule D the name of any other Chamber of Commerce in the United Kingdom whose endorsements he will accept.

5. TEXTILES OF ONE PART OF COMMONWEALTH IMPORTED FROM ANOTHER. When textiles of kinds above-mentioned are the produce or manufacture of the United Kingdom or Hong Kong and are imported into the Colony from another part of the Commonwealth, the Treasurer may admit the same provided that they are accompanied by a certificate from the Customs authorities of the last port of shipment certifying that such textiles were supported at their admission by a certificate as required by these regulations.

6. FORM OF DECLARATION. The declaration required by section 4 of the Textiles Quota Ordinance (herein called the "Ordinance") shall be in the form set out in the Schedule G.

7. RETURNS. The return required by section 4 of the Ordinance shall be made upon the relative import entry warrant form.

8. RECORD OF QUOTA IMPORTS. Any person who shall require the Treasurer to furnish information or a statement as provided by sub-section (2) of section 5 of the Ordinance shall be given such information free of charge.
