AN ACT TO AMEND THE QUARANTINE ACT (CAP. 14.09).

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Montserrat, and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1 Short title

This Act may be cited as the Quarantine (Amendment) Act, 2020.

2 Interpretation

In this Act " $\mathbf{principal}$ \mathbf{Act} " means the Quarantine Act (Cap.14.09).

3 Section 4(1) amended

Section 4(1) of the principal Act is amended—

- (a) deleting "." in paragraph (b) and substituting ";"; and
- (b) by inserting the following as paragraph (c)—

"(c) the spread of infection, by community transmission."

4 Section 4(2) amended

Section 4(2) of the principal Act is amended by—

- (a) deleting "." in paragraph (i) and substituting ";"; and
- (b) by inserting the following paragraphs—
 - "(j) the examination and screening of persons in Montserrat who, in the opinion of a Health Officer, is likely to be infected with an infectious disease;
 - (k) the questions to be answered and information to be supplied by a person in Montserrat who, in the opinion of a Health Officer, is likely to be infected with an infectious disease;
 - (1) the surveillance, monitoring, quarantining or isolation of a person who, in the opinion of a Health Officer is likely to be infected with an infectious disease;
 - (m) the isolation and treatment of a person who is infected with an infectious disease; and
 - (n the establishment of quarantine and isolation facilities."

5 Section 7 amended

Section 7 of the principal Act is amended by deleting "\$960" wherever it appears and substituting "\$2000".
