OF THE MONTSERRAT CONSTITUTION ORDER (CAP 1.01).**

A PROCLAMATION BY THE GOVERNOR

ANDREW PEARCE

WHEREAS the Montserrat Constitution Order (Cap.1.01) (the Order) was made by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council on 13th October, 2010;

AND WHEREAS the Order was laid before the Parliament of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland on the 20th day of October, 2010;

AND WHEREAS section 1(2) of the Order provides that the Order shall come into force on such day as the Governor, acting in his discretion may appoint by proclamation published in the Gazette;

AND WHEREAS by proclamation (S.R.O 40/2011) published in the Gazette the Governor appointed the 27th of day of September, 2011 as the date the Order comes into force except section 18(1) to (8);

AND WHEREAS section 1(3) of the Order gives the Governor, acting in his discretion, the power to appoint a later date for the coming into force of section 18 (1) to (8);
