A PROCLAMATION BY THE GOVERNOR
ANDREW PEARCE

WHEREAS section 58(1) of the Montserrat Constitution Order (Cap 1.01) provides that there shall be at least one session of the Legislative Assembly in every year;

AND WHEREAS section 58(1) of the Montserrat Constitution Order (Cap. 1.01) also provides that a session of the Legislative Assembly shall be held within one month after every general election at such time and place as the Governor may appoint by proclamation published in the *Gazette*;

NOW THEREFORE, I, ANDREW PEARCE, Governor, appoint the 17th day of December, 2019 at 9 a.m., at the Cultural Centre in Little Bay as the time and place at which the first sitting of the next session of the Legislative Assembly shall be held.
